We're passing along some great pricing on a few of our favorite trees. This is a special deal from one of our regional suppliers. These trees are grown at about 5500' elevation south of Cheyenne, so they are well adapted to our climate. We have personally visited the tree farm and inspected the fields. We buy trees from this grower and can vouch for their consistent, uniform quality. They are irrigated in a manner that promotes deep root development, so they are pre-primed for more drought-affected sites. These trees are NOT park grade or rejects!

This is a special price we can only offer this spring based on availability from the grower. All trees are 1.75" B&B (weigh about 250 lbs.). A description and price of the varieties available is as follows:

- \$210.00 ea.** **Tatarian Maple (13027):** This small upright tree grows to 25' tall, the perfect maple when you don't have room for a 50' tree. In mid- to late summer the samaras turn bright red, and last for weeks—a great show when all other flowering trees are done! The dark green foliage turns yellow in the fall, but may surprise with some red and orange as well. This tree is very tolerant of alkalinity and dry conditions.
- \$170.00 ea.** **Patmore Ash (13071):** This seedless cultivar of native Green Ash develops a uniform elliptical crown and grows up to 50' tall. This is one of the most classic, versatile, all-around tough, easy-to-grow trees available. It has vivid yellow fall color and works well for shade in summer or as a windbreak.
- \$210.00 ea.** **Flowering Crabapples:** We are offering some of our favorite hardy and showy Flowering Crabs. All of these flower profusely in the spring and are some of the most easy to grow ornamental trees. The **Spring Snow Crab (12606)** (20-25') flowers white but does NOT produce fruit. The **Thunderchild Crab (20617)** (15') has pink flowers in spring followed by deep purple leaves in summer and dark red fruit in fall. The **Radiant Crab (12601)** (15') offers deep pink flowers followed by bright red, PERSISTENT fruit (the fruit stays on the tree in winter), and green leaves turning to orange-red in fall. Birds also love the fruiting varieties of flowering crabapples.
- \$210.00 ea.** **Cottonless Cottonwoods:** Two cottonless varieties (**Lanceleaf** and **Highland (12617)**) are more useful for residential and windbreak plantings. They are vigorous, disease resistant, and seedless, growing to 45' tall. These are some of the fastest growing trees around. Also offered is **Jeronimus (13736)**, a cottonless version of the native Plains cottonwood, which will grow to 60-70'.
- \$220.00 ea** **Honeylocust:** We've offered the **Skyline (17861)** and **Imperial Honeylocust (12508)** for years. These are strong, sturdy trees giving more filtered shade rather than dense shade. They are thornless and essentially seedless with dainty, refined foliage giving them a graceful, ornamental appeal. The Skyline grows to 50', while the Imperial can get 35'. Once they are established these trees tend to be very heat and drought tolerant.
